
THE DISEASE & RESEARCH

An estimated 2 million people were diagnosed with cancer in the United States in 2025, over 39,000 people in Wisconsin*. The Badger Challenge raises critical funds to support local cancer research at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. There are over 100 different types of cancer, and each type requires different treatments. The Badger Challenge drives research in every type of cancer.

Over 80 Badger Challenge scholars have received funding to a variety of cancer research areas including:

- NanoMedicine
- Targeted Therapies
- Cancer Genomics
- Therapeutic Resistance




